## **The Aim of the Symposium**

The aim of the Symposium is to bring together experts in kinesiological education with different experience to discuss the current developments of kinesiological ideas regarding individualizing instruction, especially in pre-school and primary school education. In view of the topicality of this issue and the respectability of the 19<sup>th</sup> Summer School for Kinesiology 2010, which discusses this issue on a wider level, the social and civilization movements, the scientific interest connected to this issue, the conclusion may be that the year 2010 has become the year promoting individualizing instruction in kinesiological teaching methods. All the papers peer-reviewed by two independent reviewers will be published in the Conference Proceedings. The conference intends to attract professionals, students and academics alike.

## **The Current Situation**

The contemporary conception of conducting exercise, as well as the entire educational process is incomprehensible without respecting the principle of individualising instruction. Primarily because success in any human field of activity and especially in those that refer to working with people depends on the extent to which their authentic needs, interests and desires are met (Findak, 1999). In kinesiological education, which implies the transformation of anthropological status with the simultaneous increase in the level of motor and theoretical knowledge and the level of motor achievements, individualizing instruction becomes the only possible way. Providing maximum adjustment of the programme of physical exercise to individual characteristics of any person with predetermined aims, becomes inconceivable without knowing the anthropological status (Findak, 1999)- relevant determinants of an individual and the starting point for the individualised instruction. The aim here is to answer the questions about the possibilities of individualised instruction in kinesiological education in order to ensure its prospects, especially during the most sensitive stages of education. It is evident that kinesiological education should have the greatest effect on the entire population, because it monitors humans from pre-school to higher education (Prskalo and Babin, 2006) and therefore presents the most numerous applied field of kinesiology, has the greatest challenges and limitations in applying individualised instruction, but, simultaneously it has the greatest responsibility for the state of the nation in the narrower, and population in the wider sense.

The topic of the Symposium particularly deals with curricular changes in Europe and in Croatia, where the scientific conference conclusions, including this symposium, could have and should have influence on the changes of kinesiological knowledge.

The Symposium is part of the scientific project (Kinesiological education in preschool and primary education), executed with the support of the Ministry of Science, Education and Sports of the Republic of Croatia.

Papers that address any of the above listed issues are invited. An abstract of approximately 200 words should be submitted for evaluation. All the proposals will be evaluated on the basis of their scholarly quality, originality and potential for further development. ### **Evaluation and Publication in the Conference-Symposium Proceedings**

All papers submitted on time will be peer-reviewed. Final papers (ready for print, including appendices and reference list) should not exceed 15 single-spaced typed pages (approximately 30,000 characters), and should be prepared in accordance with the instructions given to the authors. The paper is written in English with the Abstract and key words in English and Croatian.

The authors take full responsibility for the quality of the preparation of papers.

The authors take full responsibility for the appropriateness, quality and the translation of their papers. Length: Papers should not exceed 16 pages (including titles, authors, affiliations, abstract, key words, the text, tables, charts or illustrations and references)

“Page” implies A4 size (21 x 29.7 cm; page setup portrait), white paper, with all four margins of 3 cm. Notes (avoided where possible) should be added at the end of the paper.

Font: Times New Roman (TNR), font size 11m, spacing 1.5; Arial Narrow (AN) in tables, font size 10, spacing 1.0. justified alignment.

Title, upper case: font size 14, bold, spacing 1.5, centred alignment.

Followed by an empty line and the author's/authors' name and surname (TNR, 11pts, bold), separated with a comma. The presenter's name should be underlined.

The authors' names and affiliations are followed by an empty line. Each author should be matched to his or her institution with the number in the exponent. Institutions are presented by numbers, name of the institution, city and state. Each institution name is written in a separate line.

There should be two empty lines between the name of the institution and the Abstract.

Text organisation: Each text should consist of the title, abstract, key words (6 words that have not already been mentioned in the title) and the text itself. Italics can be used to emphasise important parts within the text, if necessary.

Abstract: the body of the text (TNR, 11 pts). Justified alignment. One paragraph only, key words written in a separate line.

Paper should be divided into subsections with subtitles (TNR, 11 pts, bold, justified alignment). One empty line follows.

Experimental papers: Introduction, Research Methods, Results, Discussion and Conclusion, Reference (in the text, references should include author's surname, publication year; when three or more authors are quoted, the first author's surname and "et al." is written. At the end of the paper reference list should be in alphabetical order. “Harvard reference system” is recommended.

Pages should be numbered. Footnotes are not allowed. Subtitles should not be numbered. The paper will be printed in black and white; therefore, colour illustrations are redundant.

Tables, charts, and illustrations: Black and white illustrations should be included in the text. Tables (Arial Narrow, 10 pts; listed as “Table”, numbered using Arabic numerals continuously in the entire paper. Tables should not be sent as images nor should be “locked”. Each illustration should have its own title and description –above the tables and under the charts, pictures and photographs.

All graphics should be of highest quality and digital photographs should contain min 300 dpi; jpeg or .tiff format. The authorship of all the materials used in the paper should be credited.

All the papers submitted on time and selected (positively reviewed by two independent reviewers) and the presented papers for which the conference fee has been paid, will be published in the Pre-Conference-Symposium Proceedings and distributed at the Symposium.
